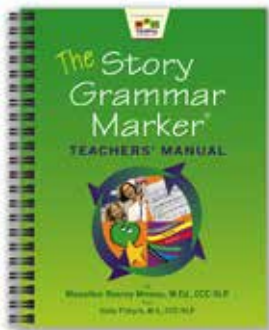

STORY GRAMMAR MARKER WORKSHOP

This highly interactive workshop will focus on narrative development, utilizing the research-based methodology and tool, The Story Grammar Marker® which has been used since 1991 to help children think, communicate and learn. Through modeling, activities, lecture and demonstration, the presenter will share a researched-based methodology to teach narrative macrostructure & microstructure and to effectively collaborate with other professionals; both of which influence oral language, writing, comprehension, critical thinking and social emotional development of students.



MATHEMATICS WORKSHOP

One of the most challenging topics to teach students is how to solve word problems. By using close reading, annotation at individual sentence levels prior to making mathematical connections at the multi-sentence level, you will demonstrate the ability to use and teach students a structured approach to problem solving.

You will become adept at justifying mathematical arguments through pictures, symbols, and language. In this manner, conceptual and procedural understanding are integrated and equally emphasized within each problem.

Utilizing mathematical text you are familiar with and use in your current practice, you will create unit concept maps, vocabulary word maps, and supporting expository maps to facilitate student learning.



READING WORKSHOP

Participants will learn how to promote higher level student thinking through comprehension strategies instruction. The Story Grammar Marker®, mental imagery, making inferences, and depth of knowledge questioning will be a few of the tools introduced and modeled. This hands-on class will provide all participants with materials and opportunities to apply these strategies.



WRITING WORKSHOP

This course will focus on integrating Story Grammar Marker®, Thememaker, process writing and six traits using G Suite for Education applications. We will provide strategies for narrative and expository writing including the use of graphic organizers, conferences, and technology tools.



THE PROGRAM

Each workshop is \$800 which includes a kit for Story Grammar Marker® for week one. Math, Reading and Writing materials, handouts and supplies will be provided to develop classroom teaching tools as needed.

Each workshop will run from Monday - Thursday 12PM-3PM with snacks and refreshments.

Participants will be invited to attend the program in the morning to observe the use of these materials and strategies with language learning disabled students.
