# CAPE COD PROGRAMS

We provide community-based outreach services for families, adolescents, and young adults living on Cape Cod and the surrounding areas.

The focus of our services include promoting home stability and permanence, working toward a variety of personal goals, and providing case management and support for both the individual and family. Families include the immediate support system for the child which include biological, adoptive and foster parents, as well as kinship placements.



# FAMILY SUPPORT PROJECT (FSP)

FSP serves youth ages 12-17. As a wrap-around service, we work closely with members of our client's Care Team to support the individual in need of services. The goal is to help the youth to be successful both in their home environment and community.

The FSP Team engage youth and caretakers in both their homes and community to provide advocacy and case management in a therapeutic setting. Services provided include:



Mentoring in problem-solving, decision making and conflict resolution.



Linkage to clinical support and medical appointments.



Exposure to positive risk-taking.



Transportation Services.



Educational assistance.



Parental/caretaker support.

Clients attend programming 3 days weekly and collateral supports are available daily.



After-School Hours: pick-up times are dependent on school dismissals and drop-offs start at 5:30 pm



Summer Hours: 12pm to 4pm

## FAMILY ASSESSMENT & MENTORING SERVICES (FAMS)

FAMS supports transitional aged youth 16 to 22 in developing/enhancing life skills, independent living and maintaining both physical and mental health.

This model also supports children 12 to 16 years of age to improve social engagement with peers, learn new life skills and maintain in both their home and community environments.

## FAMS (continued)

The FAMS model is an individualized mentoring and caretaker support service. At FAMS we strive to promote:



A safe home environment and increased stability.



Improved caretaker/child relationship.



Increased community awareness and involvement.



Increased vocational skills and employability.



Consistent engagement in clinical services.



Achievement with educational placement and support, improved parenting capacity, engagement in positive recreational and leisure activities.



Support with meeting medical and dental treatment needs.

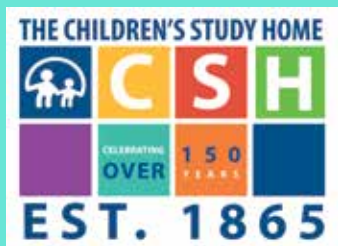


# About Us
