

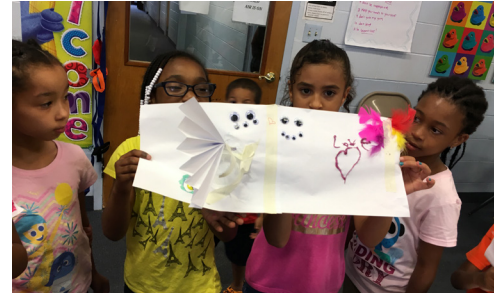


## VOLUNTEER AT OUR COMMUNITY PROGRAMS

The Children's Study Home is a 154 year old non-profit organization supporting children and families throughout the Pioneer Valley, Berkshires and Cape Cod regions with educational, residential and family services.

### CAMP CASA PROGRAM

Camp CASA is an educational and affordable summer camp that supports the children of Springfield. In 2019, Camp CASA was very successful with 40 campers enrolled, with a waiting list of over 20 campers. The 2019 summer program was held for six weeks from July 8th - August 16th on Sherman Street.

Secret Santa is our most robust volunteer effort at The Children's Study Home. With the community's help, we have been able to put smiles on children's faces and help families feel the joy of the winter gift giving during the holidays. 2018 being the 153rd year, we granted over 400 children their wishes!
